My Name is Michael Bolduc and I serve as the Board President for the National Disabled Veteran Business Council, Inc., a Florida Registered 501 (c) 19 Veteran Service Organization headquartered in West Palm Beach, FL. The NDVBC is a Nationally Recognized Veteran Service Organization by the Central VA Office in Washington, D.C.

The NDVBC advocates for Veterans in business and has been the point of the spear with developing and operating Veteran initiatives for over five years in South Florida, all from an empowerment platform, coupled with oversight and accountability of not-for-profit Veteran programs.

The reason for this letter:

For years, the NDVBC has been experiencing hostile behavior from several staff of the Career Source of West Palm Beach, to include complete refusal to recognize the NDVBC as well as to never assist or ever refer Veterans to the many positive Veteran initiatives the NDVBC offers. Recently this egregious behavior has escalated to publicly defaming the NDVBC to other community based agency employees and local County employees, to include slandering specific NDVBC Board members.
